- Do a drawing based on one of the great <u>architectural</u> <u>triumphs of the</u> <u>world</u>. (ex: Taj Mahal, Stonehenge, Burj al Arab, Notre Dame, Eiffel Tower, etc.)
- 2. Create an image that emphasizes <u>anger</u>; make your viewer 'feel' your anger. Use full colour.
- 3. Draw an image that within it contains a <u>sleeping figure</u>. Work with making the figure appear fairly *mysterious*.
 - 4. Claude Monet, the father of Impressionism, had a November birthday. Create a <u>colour detail of one of Monet's impressionist</u> works.
 - 5. November 17th is <u>World Peace Day.</u> <u>Design an image</u> that might possibly grace a card celebrating this. Avoid clichés.
- 6. Divide your sketchbook page in two. On one side, draw something large really, really small. On the other draw something tiny really, really big. Then erase the line and try to make the composition unified.
- 7. Design a page full of snowflakes. Remember no two are alike. This can be a collage if you so choose!
 - 8. Free Draw; spend 1 hour on your 'free'.
