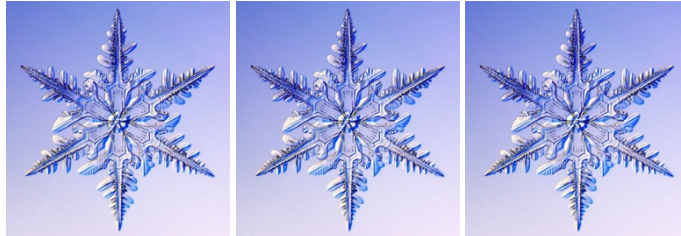


# November Sketches

## Visual Arts 12

Due: **Monday, November 30<sup>th</sup>**



1. Find a drawing of an object that you would want to draw eight different times. Divide up your sketchbook page into eight equal squares and within each square find a non-traditional art material to render the object with (ex: seeds, noodles, string, nail polish, etc.) so that the result is eight intriguing squares. Your first square should be a simple pencil drawing of the object! (this is worth two drawings/2+ hrs.)
2. Choose one of the following titles, which are from famous painting titles, and work towards a colour creation designed to suit the chosen title-  
*The Little Pastry Cook, Death and Funeral of Cain*  
*Seated Woman with Bent Knee* or *Saint Paul the Hermit*
3. Keeping in mind the precision of medical illustrations, draw a colour version of the human heart that would be fit for Gray's Anatomy!
4. Design a composition around spent paint tubes. See Ms. Perry if you need some old tubes for observation.
5. Draw a picture of someone taking a picture.
6. Show the viewer something that relates to your earliest childhood memory. Include text/prose that fills us in.
7. "Free Draw"; Always spend a minimum of one hour on either several sketches **OR** one finished work.
